COVID-19 Update/Response

For Immediate Release

There have been recent reports and posts on other websites and social media locations that are not the official Big Horn County information sharing platform indicating that there are two additional COVID-19 cases in Big Horn County. On Sunday June 7th 2020 the Big Horn County Public Health Department received notification of two individuals testing positive for COVID-19. Both are adult females.

Announcements placed on the official County sites are all verified by the state and in accordance with national Incident Command Systems models. This site and facebook pages for Big Horn County, Big Horn County Emergency Management and the Big Horn County Public Health Office are the only official sites for releasing information.

These are the 6th and 7th residents of Big Horn County who have tested positive to date. These cases are not related to the previous positives in our county. This underscores the need to continue safe exposure reduction practices as have been emphasized throughout this emergency. Community support and compliance is imperative at every level to protect our citizens. Safety is up to you. Representatives from the county are working to ensure the health and safety of our residents.

Information regarding COVID-19 is available throughout the area including the County and Public Health Department websites and Facebook. Local agencies will continue to provide community education about mitigation efforts such as social distancing. Evidence from other affected cities and countries clearly shows that areas that initiated mitigation measures prior to widespread community transmission are significantly better able to address their community's needs.
